

## FISU FREESTYLE SKIING SPORTS REGULATIONS

### 1. GENERAL TERMS

1.1 The freestyle skiing events will be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the International Ski Federation (FIS), except when specifically amended with these regulations or by the CTI-UH. In any dispute the English text will be regarded as authoritative.

1.2 The programme and duration of the competitions will be fixed by the Executive Committee in agreement with the Organising Committee and the CTI-UH.

In principle, the programme will last a maximum of eight (8) days and may include the following events:

1.3 Ski cross + at least one (1) other from the above shall be chosen by the OC. The event chosen by the OC has to be presented to the FISU EC for approval at the latest 48 months before the WU opening ceremony.

1.4 Each country may enter:

**Men:** Four (4) athletes in each individual event

**Women:** Four (4) athletes in each individual event

Mixed Aerial Team Event:

Each country may enter a maximum of two (2) teams. Each team consists of 2 athletes (one (1) man - one (1) woman).

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official entry list of competitors.

Only competitors with an active FIS code are allowed to participate in each freestyle skiing event. Entries are controlled by the Organiser and the FIS Technical Delegate. Only accredited athletes can be considered for the draw of a starting list.

## 2. PRE COMPETITION PROCEDURE

### 2.1 Advanced Payment:

Two (2) months before the Winter Universiade, countries entering in freestyle skiing must confirm their participation with an advanced payment of 50 % of the participation fees per entered competitor and official (cf. WU General Regulations Art. 5.3.6).

The advanced payment shall be directly collected by the Organising Committee.

The Organising Committee must invite the ITOs no later than three (3) months before the opening ceremony of the Winter Universiade (cf. WU Technical Regulations Art. 10.4).

Per diem according to FISU-FIS partnership agreement are to be paid for the entire days of duty (including travel days). (cf. WU Technical Regulations Art. 10.3).

#### 3.4 Arrival and departure days

Unless otherwise stated by the FISU CTI-UH, all international technical officials are to arrive one (1) day prior to their first official meeting as agreed between FISU and the OC and depart one (1) day after the end of competition. (cf. WU Technical Regulations Art. 10.5).

ITO's are to be accommodated in single rooms. (cf. WU Technical Regulations Art. 10.5).
