

Rules and Regulations Gwangju 2015 FISU Photo Competition

The Gwangju 2015 FISU Photo Competition ("Competition") is launched by FISU (International University Sports Federation) during Summer Universiade 2015 in order to **encourage the participants to take, share and comment on their photos in relation to the sports competitions, cultural events, social life and their unique experience within the Universiade.**

The Competition is open to any regularly registered person having received an accreditation in the Summer Universiade as a student-athlete, a team staff member, a VIP or an observer. Participants must be at least 18 years old. Participants must be amateurs as far as photography is concerned (i.e. no professional photographers).

The Competition will open on July 3, 2015 and close on July 15, 2015 (at noon Gwangju time). Award winners will be announced on July 22, 2015 on FISU website and Facebook.

Photographs shall be **submitted via email** to photoGwangjufisu@gmail.com. The subject line of the email shall read "FISU Photo Competition." The text of the email must include an entrant's first name, last name, accreditation status (student-athlete/staff/other), country, and accreditation number. Participants are also encouraged to post the photos on their Instagram and Flickr with hashtag #SUGwangju2015FISUPhotoCompetition.

Photos which have been submitted, and which, comply with the current regulations, will be displayed in the dedicated **Album on FISU Facebook "Gwangju 2015 FISU Photo Competition"**. Universiade participants will be allowed to view it, like it, share it and comment on it.

Winners will be selected based on a **combination of the number of "likes"** a photograph receives on the FISU Facebook page **and the assessment of the Jury**. All decisions of the Jury are final. The following criteria will guide the decisions of the Jury: originality, creativity, links to the Universiade, impact of the message, overall quality.

The Awards will consist of a set of FISU special gadgets. There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prizes. Prizes are "not transferable". By winning any items from FISU, the winner and the user of the item(s) releases FISU from any responsibility for any incident related to the use of the item(s).

All photos submitted become the property of FISU, and may be used by FISU for promotional purposes. Information about the author will appear wherever a photo may be used except for the FISU Album where the photos are stored for the purpose of the competition without the names of the authors.

Participants grant FISU and its licensees an irrevocable, perpetual, non-exclusive, royalty-free, transferable, sub-licensable and worldwide licence to reproduce, copy, publicly perform, publicly display, publish, reformat, translate, excerpt (in whole or in part), distribute, prepare derivative works (including collections) of, incorporate into other works and otherwise use and exploit any photographs submitted in connection with the competition for promoting and advertising FISU and any derivative works thereof in any media formats and through any media channels, and to grant and authorize sub-licenses of the foregoing. Further, participants understand that photographs will be publicly available to others and that FISU has no obligation to prevent the unauthorized copying, dissemination, alteration or other use of the photographs by others.

Photos which contain any offensive content or act against the spirit of FISU will not be admitted to the competition.

Winners may be required to sign a release. All winners agree to allow FISU to use their name, voice and/or likeness, portrait, and biographical information for promotional purposes without further compensation.

Any disputes regarding these rules will be settled by the FISU. All decisions of the Jury are final.

By entering the competition, participants agree to abide by these rules.
