

NETBALL

1. GENERAL TERMS

The netball tournament shall be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the International Netball Federation (INF). In any dispute, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The programme and duration of competitions shall be fixed by the FISU Executive Committee in agreement with the Organising Committee and the CTI. The programme shall last up to five (5) days from the opening ceremony to the closing ceremony and include the following events:

- One (1) women's tournament: maximum twelve (12) teams.

The tournament shall be organised indoor.

Each country may enter a maximum seventeen (17) persons: twelve (12) competitors and five (5) officials. Each participating country must present:

- One (1) team composed of a maximum of twelve (12) players.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

2. PRE-COMPETITION PROCEDURE

The countries participating in the netball tournament shall pay a deposit of 5000 EUR per team to guarantee registration (Art. 5.4.4).

This deposit shall be paid to FISU at the latest five (5) months prior to the start of the Championship; failing this, the entries shall not be taken into consideration.

Seeding and draw

The draw will take place three (3) months before the event, after a seeding is established on the basis of the results achieved in the previous WUC, the INF world ranking at the moment of the draw and continental distribution.

3. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

3.1 Nomination and costs

International umpires shall be appointed jointly by INF and FISU. The participating delegations shall bear their costs of travel, board and lodging in proportion to the number of teams registered (from one (1) day before the opening ceremony to one (1) day after the closing ceremony).

Other costs are referenced in the FISU – INF partnership agreement.

The Organising Committee shall announce the exact sum shortly after the closing date for nominative entries (one (1) month before the beginning of the World University Championship).

The ratio per team will be one (1) plus one (1) additional umpire per event to be respected.

3.2 Number of technical officials needed

These officials will come from the host country and neighbouring countries.

They will be appointed by INF's technical representative for the WUNC in conjunction with the National Netball Federation of the country hosting the WUNC and ratified by the Netball TD & FISU WUC Department.

NTOs

Minimum of 2 scorers, 2 time keepers and 2 statistic personnel per game.

The costs for the travel and the stay of the NTOs shall be covered by the Organising Committee.
